#### **IESO** releases 2021 Annual Planning Outlook

The 2021 outlook, released on December 10th, projects a significant amount of both change and opportunity in the sector over the next two decades as the province's supply mix begins to evolve and newer sources of electricity demand play a prominent role in driving future needs.

#### **OPG** selects **GE** Hitachi to build Canada's first SMR

GE Hitachi Nuclear Energy, a North Carolina energy company, will build Canada's next nuclear power plant in Clarington, Ont., about 82 km east of downtown Toronto on the shore of Lake Ontario. OPG and GE Hitachi will collaborate on the SMR engineering, design, planning, preparing the licencing and permitting materials, and performing site preparation activities, with the mutual goal of constructing Canada's first commercial, grid-scale SMR, projected to be completed as early as 2028.

# APPrO 2021 Conference: Leaders urge industry to prepare for change

Chuck Farmer, the Vice President of Planning for the IESO, explained that after years of static demand we are entering a period of growth, potentially much higher growth in the longer term, partly the result of an anticipated upsurge in manufacturing in southwestern Ontario, partly because of the imperative for decarbonization which is fuelling a spike in electric vehicle sales. "Economic growth and electrification are reshaping the landscape," said Farmer.

In preparation for its December 15 Stakeholder Engagement meeting, the IESO released a series of materials to set the stage for further development of its Resource Adequacy framework. Newly released information includes 2022 Capacity Auction enhancements, the supporting draft market rule and manual amendments and an update on the Long-Term RFP.

Bruce Power announced the issuance of \$500 million in Green Bonds, which is a global first for nuclear power and a recognition of the critical role the technology plays in fighting climate change and enabling a net-zero future.

#### IEA says renewable power installations are set for a record year

The world is set to add nearly 290 gigawatts of renewable power capacity this year, according to the International Energy Agency, with the Paris-based organization expecting 2021 to "set a fresh all-time record for new installations." Published on December 1, the IEA's Renewables Market Report forecasts that the planet's renewable electricity capacity will jump to more than 4,800 GW by the year 2026, an increase of over 60% compared with 2020 levels.
