## Minister issues procurement directive

Ontario Energy Minister Todd Smith formalized the government's expectations for the IESO's procurement plans in a directive on January 28. Work already underway on the Capacity Auction, the Medium-Term Request for Proposals (MT RFP), and the Long-Term Request for Proposals (LT RFP) has been firmly reinforced. Contracts with several power projects were mandated. The directive followed quickly on two earlier mandates to continue work on the Lake Erie Connector and a Provincial Clean Energy Credit Registry.

## Long Term RFP engagement underway

On February 8, the IESO presented the initial design elements for the Long Term RFP and Contract. It also shared plans for a related stakeholder engagement process and invited comments from interested parties. It will issue an RFQ in advance of the LT RFP on or before June 30, 2022. APPrO confirmed that some of its recommendations on structure were reflected in the early design proposal. The LT I RFP is intended to acquire capacity from incremental new-build supply and storage resources.

## **Pathways to Decarbonization**

The IESO will be evaluating, at the request of the Minister of Energy, a moratorium on the procurement of new natural gas generating stations and developing an achievable pathway to achieve zero emissions in the electricity sector. The IESO's proposed study approach and assumptions will be presented for stakeholder input on February 24th.
